### 5 Priority Project Areas each led by a Primary Care Clinical Lead



#### 1. Attachment, Access and Continuity

Ensure that all residents of the Toronto Central LHIN have access to a primary care provider and are able to receive care in a timely manner.



#### 2. Access to Inter-professional Teams

Improve access to inter-professional teams for all patients of primary care provider.



#### 3. Access to Specialist Consultations

Improve and streamline access to specialists.



#### 4. Discharge Planning

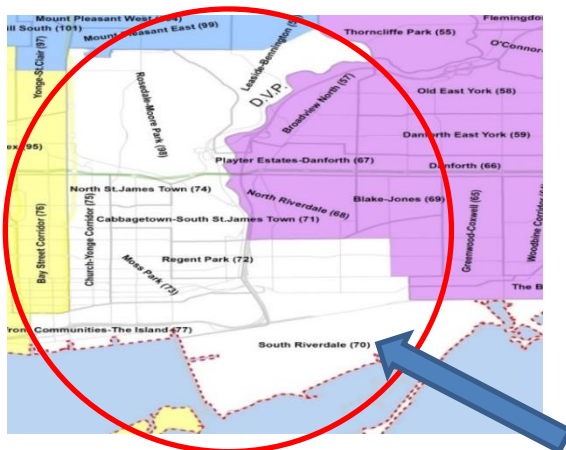
Improve the quality and timeliness of discharge summaries and to expand eNotification around patients who access emergency or inpatient care in hospital.



#### 5. Secure communication

Expand to secure communication between providers to expedite follow-up, improve care coordination, and reduce duplication of tests. Secure provider/patient communication will also be explored in this work.

### Toronto Central LHIN – Mid-East Toronto Sub-Region

**Primary Care Physicians (current): 245**

There are 5 sub-regions in the TC LHIN and each one is led by a primary care physician who is the Primary Care Clinical Lead (PCCL).
